- Excellence in Governance helps boards create lasting, adaptive change, and transform from responsible to exceptional. Using a performance-based framework paired with curriculum and coaching on effective governance principles, the program helps enhance board culture and strengthen long-term business approach. Each board defines and measures their own success in the context of the organization and the community it serves. So far, 5 "rounds" have taken place, and 63 organizations (not all network) have been served.

NCHEC Certifications

 Earn a certification in one or more of seven areas focused on elements of housing education and counseling and financial capability. Each certification can be completed in as little as one week of in-person instruction. Specialized certifications in homeownership and the rapidly emerging financial capability field facilitate approval and possible funding from HUD, allow adoption of the Industry Standards, and require regular renewal.

National Industry Standards

- The National Industry Standards for Homeownership Education and Counseling are a set of guidelines for quality homeownership and counseling services. Industry professionals who adopt them can be trusted to provide consistent, high quality advice. These standards have been created by a committee comprising people from a broad range of industry organizations including nonprofit, government and financial services industry. Currently almost 1,400 adopters across the country.
